Objective

The objective of this report is to measure the socio-economic conditions within the WNMF in comparison to the rest of the country.

Description

This report monitors community sustainability in the Western Newfoundland Model Forest. Specific focus is placed on the communities of Corner Brook, Pasadena, Lark Harbour, and Rocky Harbour as these are representative of the area's community types. Two different social indicator approaches are used: objective measures in the form of Canadian census data, and subjective measures from personal interviews with community residents.
